 - O Working with West Coast International which is currently performing due diligence on constructing an 8,000 sq ft building in Olympic View Industrial Park.
 - o American Cruise lines visit to Bremerton Marina on Easter. Discussion with the Board on moorage fees and City participation.
 - o Recognizing James Weaver and the Port's lobbyist team for their efforts in submitting the RAISE (Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity) federal grant application for the Port Orchard Marina breakwater reconstruction project.
 - o Projects: Multi-Purpose Facility and Taxiway Relocation/Apron Rehabilitation
 - o French delegation visit to Kitsap County and the Port on April 15. Commissioner Strakeljahn provided detail on the delegation and, in response to a question by Commissioner Anderson, discussed the importance of building relationships with these types of businesses. Commissioner Bozeman responded that it is also important to make sure the investment in building those relationships produces results for the taxpayers and brings in new companies to our community.

• Discussed his top three priorities with potential concerns: 1) providing parking for Bremerton Marina tenants; 2) Port Orchard Marina breakwater replacement project; 3) 232 acres of industrial land currently being leased out for potential racetrack.

- Supports Commissioner Bozeman's priority concerns as those items are also on the top
 of his list.
- Attending the Washington Public Ports Association Spring Conference next week and looking forward to the experience.
