Amelia's Hangar Restaurant & Lounge is now open after holding an official ribbon cutting in April. Air traffic is becoming more active and with the good weather, many planes are dropping in for a visit to Amelia's as well.

We are pleased to once again host the American Cruise lines at the Bremerton Marina with over 46 visits this year. These visits have already begun and as you tour the waterfront you will see the large 267-foot 'American Constellation' and 205-foot 'American Spirit' ships tied to the breakwater, bringing tourists from all over the world to our county.

Our staff has worked to secure the Wings Over Washington Airshow which will be held on the 19th & 20th of August this year. This event will surely be a great addition here at Bremerton National Airport. There will be opportunities for plane rides, booths to tour, and many fun events for all. We are expecting acrobatic military demonstrations and thousands in attendance.

The legislative session for 2023 has wrapped up, and our Commission and staff have been working diligently with legislators to secure funding for the Port Orchard Marina breakwater replacement as well as funding for the Gorst interchange. The Port has taken a leadership role over the past several years to address the Gorst bottleneck and freight mobility challenges here in our community. Infrastructure improvements will benefit our region for years to come.

The CNW project is continuing to move forward. This new facility will be one of the largest improvements our community has seen in many years. It will provide a continued emergency training facility to support our first responders, as well as an outdoor amphitheater that will act as a concert area. It will also provide a home for our local C-stock theater group and many other organizations which will certainly be a draw from all over the Puget Sound region.

Lastly, I want to thank each of you on behalf of our Commission and staff for the opportunity to serve our community and provide quality service and quality facilities.

We at the Port of Bremerton are excited to announce that our Bremerton National Airport will be hosting the first air show in Bremerton in 30 years! Partnering with Freedom Fair, a 501(c)3 nonprofit, we will be showcasing aerial acrobatic displays with a military presence, a car show, armed forces displays, a variety of vendors, food options, a beer garden, and entertainment for the entire family. We look forward to welcoming everyone to our community airport for a fun, reactional activity.

Some may remember the fly-ins we've hosted in past years and while this event will be bigger, we are proud to say we will still have the car show component as well. At the Port of Bremerton, community is always our focus – whether it be generating economic development or promoting tourism, both of which will be accomplished by the air show. Bremerton Marina Welcomes Cruise Ships



We have had the exciting opportunity to host American Cruise Lines' cruise ships once again at our Bremerton Marina this year. There will be a total of 46 docking dates spanning from April 07 to November 17. The two ships in use, 'American Constellation' and 'American Spirit,' measure 267 and 205 feet in length respectively, and will be docked at our Bremerton Marina for the duration of their stays. Each ship will have upwards of 100 individuals touring Kitsap.

While in Bremerton, the cruise line will be offering those onboard tours of Kitsap activities via a coach company local to Bremerton. This will not only ensure less of an impact on local traffic but also an increased opportunity for local businesses, with some excursions including Puget Sound Navy Museum, Elandan Gardens, USS Turner Joy, Suquamish Museum, and Historic Poulsbo Exploration, among others. Furthermore, we will be offering walking maps of Bremerton to all exiting the ship. Our mission is to increase economic opportunity for all of Kitsap County, and our ability to facilitate cruise dockings is an excellent effort to this. We hope you join us in welcoming them!

The Port Orchard Marina breakwater has served for the last 40 years as a public dock, the means of protecting boats in our marina from currents and waves, and one of the places for the Suquamish Tribe's fishing. Now the dock sits closed due to public safety concerns. This nearly \$16 million structure's replacement is dependent on receiving public funds.

Our Marina staff, namely Director of Marine Facilities James Weaver, have been working tirelessly on submitting applications and attending meetings to obtain the necessary funding. The Port has also partnered with the Desimone Consulting Group to bring such grant funding needs to fruition. We are seeing their commitment pay off, literally. The Port has recently been awarded with a total of \$3 million. \$1 million was awarded by the Washington State Legislature 2023-2025 capital budget, with the additional \$2 million being awarded by the Washington State Transportation 2023-2025 budget for our plans to place charging stations on the new breakwater.

Until the replacement comes, Port staff will continue to work diligently to reduce any negative impacts on our tenants, public, and environment. We appreciate everyone's ongoing patience and support.
