

AIRCRAFT CAMPING INFORMATION

Port of Bremerton Fly-In Bremerton National Airport August 25, 2018

Thank you for attending the Port of Bremerton Fly-In at Bremerton, WA! We are excited to have you with us. Camping will be available **Friday and Saturday night only**.

Camping Area

Aircraft for camping will be in the grass in the area designated below as a yellow line. Please register at the **Aircraft Camping Reception Station** in the **Bremerton Pilot Lounge** just South of the Fuel Station.

Upon landing, **Contact Bremerton CTAF 123.05** stating your intentions to taxi to Aircraft Camping and place on aircraft glare shield the attached "C" for camping.

Taxi via "Taxiway A" to be marshalled to the designated camping area. If a Marshall is not available, choose a convenient entrance to the grass camping area from "Taxiway A". Enter and Exit Camping Area from Taxiway A only.



Campsite Rules and Responsibilities

- All Aircraft must Register at the Aircraft Camping Reception Center at the Bremerton Pilot's Lounge upon arrival.
- You are responsible for providing your own chocks/tie down equipment.
- Only one tent per plane unless a second tent is needed for immediate family members. All tents must fit within the footprint of the aircraft.
- Please use caution when starting engines to be certain pedestrians and other campers are safely away from the aircraft.
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited in the camping area.
- Smoking is prohibited in the camping area.
- Pets are permitted in the camping area, provided they are on a leash at ALL times and droppings are cleaned up.
- Coolers must remain secured at your campsite location.
- This is "primitive camping," so please be prepared for your personal comfort.

Fire Safety

Port of Bremerton strictly prohibits wood campfires, charcoal grills, and open flame anywhere on airport property and in the aircraft camping areas.

Courtesy

- ✓ Keep your campsite clean and your noise levels down.
- ✓ Please leave campsites the way you found them and place all waste in appropriate receptacles.
- ✓ Please do not hang laundry or other items.
- ✓ Please maintain appropriate clothing modesty.
